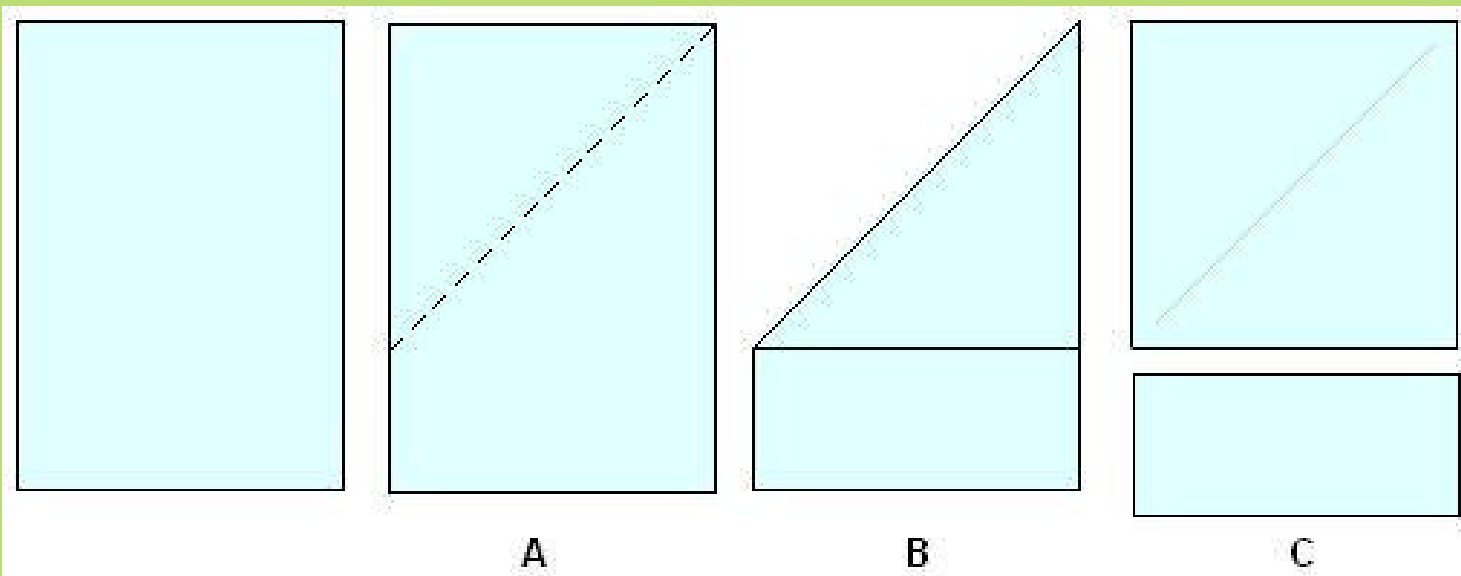
\*origami squared paper if you have it, but if not A4 paper will work.



# Easter origami bookmarks

## What do I do?

Follow these instructions to turn your A4 paper into a square.



Follow the instructions on page two to fold the paper into a bookmark.

Once you've folded your bookmark, it's now time to decorate!

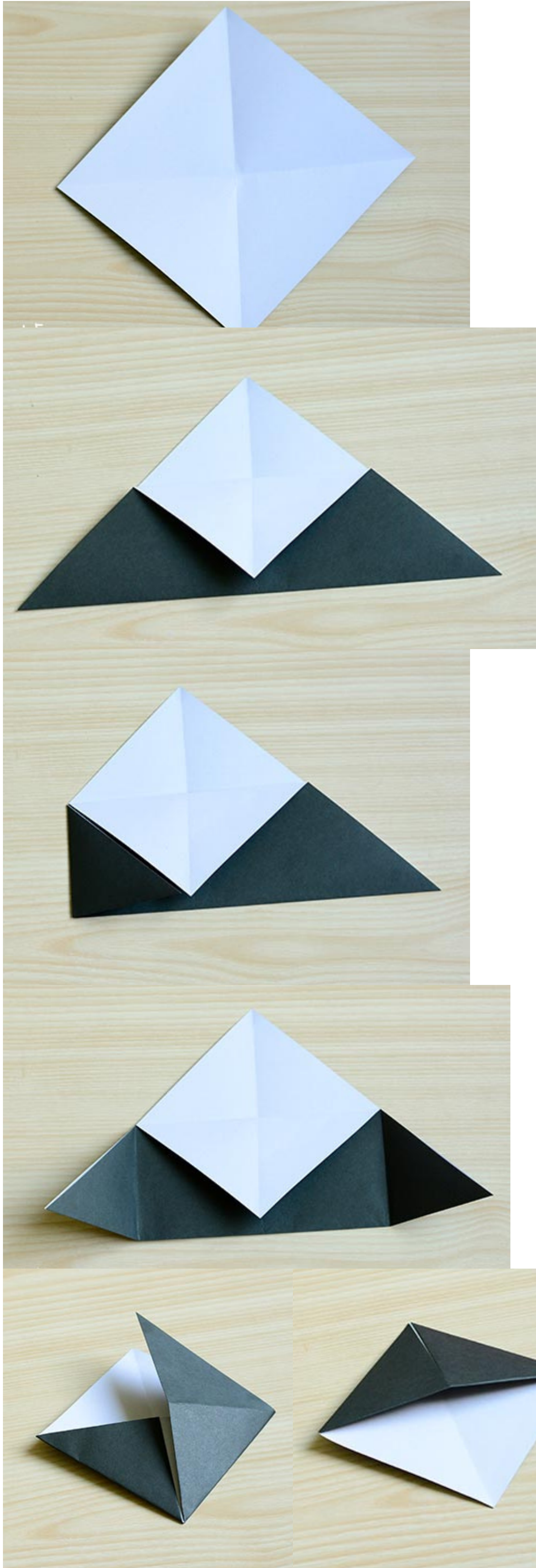
Cut out two ears and glue to the top of the reverse of the bookmark.

Using your coloured pens, draw on eyes and a nose.

Cut out a rectangle of white paper for the teeth and glue it under the nose.

Why not decorate your Easter bunny with different patterns using your coloured pens?

# Origami bookmark



Fold the paper diagonally. Unfold.

Fold into a triangle (coloured side on the outside). Grab hold of the top of the triangle (one sheet only) and fold it toward the bottom of the triangle.

Fold the left and right corner towards the bottom centre of the triangle. Crease and unfold.

Grab the corner again, this time folding it towards the top of the triangle. Crease well. Do the same with the other side. Now tuck both tops inside the pocket.

Now you have your corner bookmark. See page one to learn how to decorate it.
