



An acrostic is a particular way of writing a poem. They are written using the first letter of each line which then creates a word or phrase going down the page. Each line can then contain a word, phrase or sentence to make up a poem. They can rhyme but they certainly don't have to. Take a look at some examples below and then see if you can create your own using our Acrostic Poem Easter worksheets.

They can include just one or two words for each line.....

Eggs

Animals

 ${\color{red}\mathcal{S}}$ pringtime

Tomb

Easter bunny

Resurrection

Or they can include full sentences.....

Easter time is lots of fun,

As friends and family gather together,

Spring begins and out comes the sun,

To celebrate the life of Jesus forever,

Every bird is singing a sweet song,

 $oldsymbol{\mathsf{R}}$ abbits racing through the fields all day long.
