



# Easter Acrostic Poetry



An acrostic is a particular way of writing a poem. They are written using the first letter of each line which then creates a word or phrase going down the page. Each line can then contain a word, phrase or sentence to make up a poem. They can rhyme but they certainly don't have to. Take a look at some examples below and then see if you can create your own using our Acrostic Poem Easter worksheets.

*They can include just one or two words for each line.....*

**E**ggs  
**A**nimals  
**S**pringtime  
**T**omb  
**E**aster bunny  
**R**esurrection

*Or they can include full sentences.....*

**E**aster time is lots of fun,  
**A**s friends and family gather together,  
**S**pring begins and out comes the sun,  
**T**o celebrate the life of Jesus forever,  
**E**very bird is singing a sweet song,  
**R**abbits racing through the fields all day long.
