

Cardboard

Glue

Old magazines

Black marker pen

## What do I do?

Look through your magazines to find pages with blocks of colour. Tear the coloured parts into small pieces.

Separate your magazine pieces into the colours of the rainbow - red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo, purple. Separate the colours into light and dark shades and find some brown pieces for the centre of the flower.

Draw an outline of a sunflower onto your cardboard. Try to make your sunflower fill the page without too much space at the edge. Use the glue to cover the first petal with your red magazine pieces. Now cover the next petal with your orange pieces.

Carry on until all the petals are filled with the colours of the rainbow. Now use your brown magazine pieces to fill in the centre.

You can rip more coloured pieces from your magazine if you don't have enough.

Once your collage is finished put it in a window so your neighbours can enjoy your rainbow sunflower too!
