

Welcome to REEP's pioneering English Through Gardening project. Teaching English language to Arabic speakers through the subjects of Gardening and the Environment, the project also develops personal and cultural links between Morocco and Britain.

What is the course and who is it for?

- 8 lessons, approximately 1 hour each, with a plant or gardening theme.
- 4 parts in each lesson, including a video showing how to make something with supporting activities to teach related vocabulary.
- Adjustable for various ages, at the discretion of the teacher or leader.
- Can be done as part of a language class or as the basis for a special club.

- Most materials required for the practical activities will be easy to find, but REEP can help if there are difficulties sourcing them.

What am I expected to do and what should I expect from REEP?

- Keep in regular contact with REEP to give feedback and suggestions about the project and to discuss how it is going.
- Be prepared to be in touch with other schools in Morocco and Britain who are part of this project.
