

Title: Watering Words - Recycled Watering Can

Learning objective: To learn English words associated with watering a plant

Materials needed:

Old plastic bottle with lid
Scissors
Paints
Paintbrushes

Introduction to lesson:

In the sixth lesson, we will make a watering can recycled from a plastic bottle. You can use this to water your plants, including the plant from lesson 5. After making the watering can, we will complete three additional activities to learn the English words associated with watering plants: a vocabulary exercise, a word search and an activity to complete some sentences with missing words.

Craft activity: Recycled watering can - <https://reepinfo.org/agdz-6-craft>

Remove any labels from your plastic bottle by soaking it in warm water. Use paints to decorate your plastic bottle in a pattern or in block colours. Once dry, remove the bottle lid and carefully use scissors to pierce small holes evenly across the surface. Fill the bottle with clean water and screw the lid back on tightly. Now you can use the watering can to water the plants at home and in the garden.

Look at each of the watering words and say the English words for them. You can listen to the words and practise saying them first, then practise writing them.

Look at the different watering words you have been learning in English and try to find them all in the grid. How quickly can you find them? You must find the word by finding all the letters in the word together in the correct order - this can either be forwards, backwards, up, down or diagonal.

There are ten sentences in this activity. Each sentence has a missing word about watering. Find the correct missing word and put it in the space to complete each sentence. There is one missing word for each sentence.
